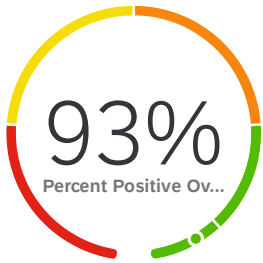

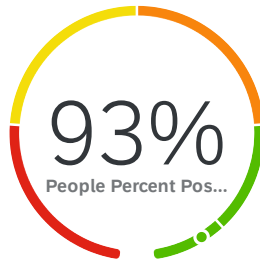

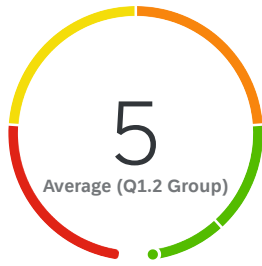

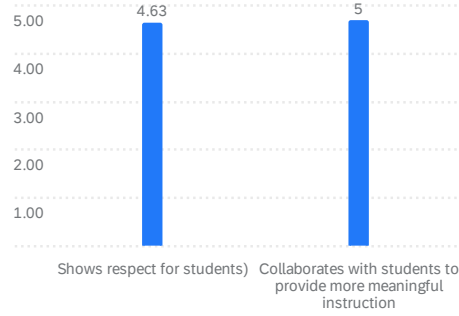


### Average Rate Positive on 5.0 Scale

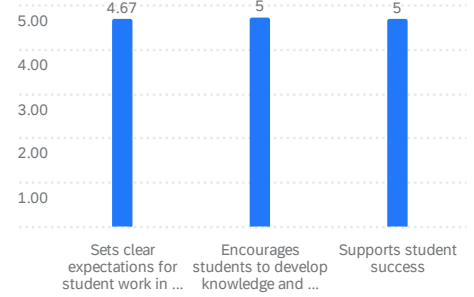

Not to mention, the professor rarely turned in grades within a reasonable time so it truly felt like I was flying blind during several points this semester. I am disappointed because the amount of pressure in this course affected my grades in another (arguably more important) course for my degree. Please MCC, do better in considering your student's needs.

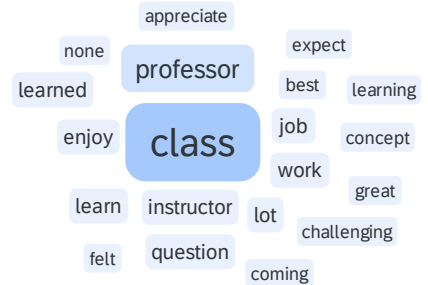
